Sr. No.	Question and Answer
Q. 1	Has your B.Ed. program received revised recognition order from the NCTE as per 2014 regulations?
Ans.	Yes. As per NCTE 2014 Regulations NRC-NCTE, Jaipur has issued the revised recognition order to School of Education, Galgotias University for conducting B.Ed. programme of two years duration with an annual intake of 100 students, for two basic units of 50 students each, from the academic session 2015-2016.
	Earlier our B.Ed. program was approved by the Northern Regional Committee, Jaipur of National Council for Teacher Education (NRC-NCTE) from the academic session 2014-2015 for 100 seats in 225th meeting of the NRC held from 25th February to 01st March, 2014; approval was mentioned in the minute at Sr. No. 362, page 48. Q. 2	Who will award the B.Ed. Degree?
Ans.	Galgotias University Uttar Pradesh will award the B.Ed. degree to its students.
Q. 3	Is Galgotias University authorised to award a degree?
Ans.	Yes . Galgotias University is a State Private University and authorised by the Uttar Pradesh Government and UGC to award the degree. Schools and Programs running under this University are not required to take affiliation from any other Government University.
Q. 4	Under which act Galgotias University has authority to do so?
Ans.	Galgotias University Uttar Pradesh was established as a State Private University in 2011 by the Uttar Pradesh State Act (Act No. 14 of 2011). This Act has been notified by the UP Government in its Notification No. 309(2)/LXXIX-V-1-11-1 (Ka) 7-2011 dated April 7, 2011. Q. 5	Does UGC recognise the degree awarded by this University?
Ans.	Yes . Degrees awarded by Galgotias University are approved by the UGC under its section 22. This University has UGC recognition under its Section 2(f). Letter of UGC recognition of Galgotias University may be viewed on the internet with the following URL:

Q. 6	Could I get government job by your B.Ed degree?
Ans.	Yes . Our B.Ed program is approved by NCTE, recognised by UGC and the University is approved as State Private University by the UP Government.

Q. 7	What is the eligibility criterion for B.Ed. admission?
Ans.	As per NCTE Regulations 2014 eligibility criterion for B.Ed. admission is Fifty percentage (50%) marks either in the Bachelor's Degree and/or Master' Degree in Sciences/Social Sciences/Humanity/Commerce, Bachelor's in Engineering or Technology with specialization in Science and Mathematics with 55% marks.
	Final year degree students may also apply for the admission.
Q. 8	(In the minimum percentage no round off is permitted.)
Q. 0	This year I am appearing/have appeared in graduation final year examination. Am I eligible to take admission in the B.Ed.?
Ans.	Yes . Final year degree students can also apply for the B.Ed. program but they have to deposit their final year mark sheet with at least 50% marks before 31st August.
Q. 9	If I have secured more than 50% marks in my previous years but unable to manage 50% marks in aggregate after final year result. In this case, may I be allowed to pursue B.Ed program?
Ans.	No . Minimum 50% marks, in aggregate, are compulsory in graduation/post graduation to pursue B.Ed program.
Q. 10	This year I have passed previous year of post graduation. Now I want to pursue B.Ed program. Is it possible?
Ans.	Yes . You can take break from your post graduation and can resume your PG after passing B.Ed; subject to the permission from the University from where you are pursuing your post graduation. You should remember that your graduation must be with at least 50% marks.
Q. 11	Whether 50% marks in Bachelor's degree means 50% marks in aggregate i.e. 50% of total marks of Honours subject + pass subject or 50% marks in Honours subject only for admission into B.Ed. programme?
Ans.	Eligibility score for admission in B.Ed. programme is at least 50% marks (i.e. aggregate of total marks in all subjects offered by the candidate) either in the Bachelor's degree and/or in the Master's Degree.
Q. 12	Whether a candidate securing 50% or more in aggregate but less than 50% marks in Honours subject is eligible for admission in B.Ed. programme?
Ans.	Yes. Such candidate is eligible for admission in B.Ed. programme, as the requirement is 50% marks in the aggregate.
Q. 13	Whether a candidate securing 50% marks or more in the Honours subject but less than 50% in aggregate in the Bachelor's degree is eligible for admission in B.Ed. programme?
Ans.	No. Such candidate is not eligible for admission to B.Ed. programme, as the requirement is 50% marks in the aggregate.
Q. 14	Does your University come under criteria of composite institutions as per the NCTE Regulation 2014?
Ans.	Yes. Any institution offering Undergraduate or/and Postgraduate programmes in Social Science /Sciences/Humanities/Commerce (B.A., B.Sc., B.Com./M.A., M.Sc., M.Com., etc.) is considered as a composite institution for the purpose of NCTE Regulations 2014.
	Any institution offering two or more than two programmes in Teacher Education also fulfils the criteria of a composite institution.

Q. 15	Whether a candidate who has undertaken MBBS/BJMC/B.Pharm./Nurshing/B.Sc. (Hotel Management)/B.Lib. or any other subject at degree level in graduation which does not come under the purview of the conventional subjects taught in schools is eligible for the B.Ed. programme?
Ans.	No. A candidate who has undertaken a professional degree other than B.Tech. (with specialization in Science and Mathematics) is not eligible for the B.Ed. programme.
Q. 16	Whether a candidate who has undertaken a degree in vocational subjects is eligible for the B.Ed. programme?
Ans.	No. A candidate who has undertaken a degree in vocational subjects is not eligible for the B.Ed. programme.
Q. 17	What is the duration of the B.Ed program?
Ans.	As per NCTE Regulations 2014 from academic session 2015-16 and onwards duration of B.Ed program is of two academic years. In our University this program will run in four Semesters.
Q. 18	What is admission process in B.Ed?
Ans.	Admissions shall be made on merit on the basis of marks obtained in the qualifying examination and/or on the basis of the entrance examination conducted by the Galgotias University.
Q. 19	Where I have to apply for B.Ed admission?
Ans.	To take admission in B.Ed program apply online at the University's website http://www.galgotiasuniversity.edu.in or visit University Campus.
Q. 20	What is the age limit for B.Ed. program?
Ans.	No upper age limit as per current norms of NCTE. But preference will be given to the
Alis.	candidates who are continuing their education without long gap.
Q. 21	What is the medium of instruction?
Ans.	Hindi and English languages are the medium of instruction in the B.Ed program.
Q. 22	What is the minimum percentage of attendance required in B.Ed.?
Ans.	A student is required to have full, 100%, attendance in each course. Condonation up to 20% can be considered for specific cogent reasons. Out of this 20%, only 10% condonation will be permitted without taking any application from the student. Rest 10% condonation may be given by the Chief Proctor to appear in each CAT and ETE on specific reason. But, in teaching practice and practical courses no condonation is permissible.
Q. 23	Due to shortage of percentage if, I become un-illegible for B.Ed then my fee will be returned?
Ans.	No fee will be refunded. Be insure about maintaining your minimum percentage before taking admission in B.Ed.
Q. 24	What if my attendance is short?
Ans.	If any student's attendance is remained below 80% then he/she will be debarred from appearing in CAT and ETE examinations.
Q. 25	Due to any medical or any other reason my attendance is below 80% then will I be allowed to appear in examinations.

Ans.	No. 20% relaxation in attendance out of 100% is including medical problems, family function(s) and other reasons.
Q. 26	If I am not allowed to appear in any End Term Examination (ETE) then how will I complete my B.Ed program?
Ans.	In this case you have to appear in ETEs next year after completing required attendance.
Q. 27	What is fee structure for B.Ed.?
Ans.	Fee structure may be seen on the University website under 'Admission' section. Separate fees are charged for 'Tuition Fee' and 'Examination Fee'.
Q. 28	Is there any scholarship available for B.Ed student?
Ans.	Yes. For detail please visit University website.
Q. 29	What are the eligibility criteria for Samaj Kalyan Department Scholarship?
Ans.	As per UP government, Samaj Kalyan Scholarship is available to only those students of all casts and religion whose parent/guardian/husband <u>annual income is less than two lac rupees</u> and candidate must be resident of Uttar Pradesh state and posses valid UP Resident certificate.
Q. 30	What is the procedure and documents required for Samaj Kalyan Department scholarship?
Ans.	For detail please visit UP Government Samaj Klayan Department website or contact Registrar office of the University.
Q. 31	Is there any Uniform for B.Ed students?
Ans.	Yes. B.Ed. students have to put on Uniform during Practice Teaching, Internship sessions and on some other specific days. They are expected to come at the University daily in the Uniform.
Q. 32	Is there any transportation available by the University?
Ans.	Yes. Galgotias University provides transportation from Botanical Garden Metro Station (Sector 37, Noida) and Campus- 1, Knowledge Park- 2, Greater Noida to the University on payment basis. Fee structure may be seen on the University website under 'Admission' section.
Q. 33	Is there hostel facility available in the University?
Ans.	Yes. Separate Hostels are available for Boys and Girls in the campus with various facilities. Fee structure may be seen on the University website under 'Admission' section.
Q. 34	How I can avail hostel facility?
Ans.	To get hostel facility visit the University website and read 'Hostel' under 'Admission' section for detail.
Q. 35	What all documents the person has to carry at the time of admission?
Ans.	Details may be seen on the University website under 'Admission' section.
Q. 36	When does the first semester session start for B.Ed?
Ans.	B.Ed. first semester session normally starts from the first half of the August or as per the announcement by the University.

Q. 37	The result of the examination is given semester-wise or after completion of B.Ed program?
Ans.	Result is announced semester wise.
Q. 38	Is the B.Ed program possible on part-time or distance basis also in GU?
Ans.	No. In GU B.Ed program is a regular and Face to Face program. One has to attend the classes regularly.
Q. 39	Is there any exemption from the classes in B.Ed? Could I be allowed not to attend the classes?
Ans.	No. It is not possible in this University.
Q. 40	If the person has done his educational qualifications from Distance learning / Open learning / Private, is he/she eligible to do B.Ed through Galgotias University?
Ans.	Yes, provided the course(s) is recognized and equivalent to examinations conducted by the recognized Boards and Universities.
Q. 41	What will be timings for B.Ed classes?
Ans.	Timing for B.Ed classes is from 9:10 am to 4:55 pm.
Q. 42	What are the job/career prospects upon completion of the B.Ed.?
Ans.	After completing B.Ed. program one can start his/her career as TGT/PGT Teacher in Government or Private Schools to teach the students of upper primary or middle level, secondary and senior secondary level as per his/her qualifications. This program also opens the door for research activities. After doing B.Ed, options are also open in various NGOs and publishing houses as content developer.
Q. 43	Is there any scope for higher education after B.Ed.?
Ans.	After doing this program one can do higher studies enrolling in Master of Education (M.Ed.) or in Master of Arts in Education (MA Education) program and then clear UGC-NET examination in Education subject and also could pursue research and Ph.D. in Education. After completing Masters in Education and meeting norms one could become Teacher Educator in the M.Ed., B.Ed. and D.Ed. (BTC/JBT) program of any Government or Private Institution. This program also opens the door for research activities After doing M.Ed.; options are also open in various NGOs and publishing houses as content developer.
Q. 44	What type of support is available for students outside of the regular curriculum to develop their communication and computer skills that are now valued by the University?
Ans.	Galgotias University is providing various personality and professional development programs for B.Ed students. To improve the English communication skills of the student a separate credit course is designed. To improve the ICT skills and to give the knowledge about Universal Human Values and Ethics two separate credit courses are being offered to the students. One course about library functioning is also offered to B.Ed students.
Q. 45	What innovation has done in the B.Ed program by the University?
Ans.	School of Education has adopted semester system in B.Ed program which is new practice in this discipline. University has adopted new B.Ed courses which are recommended by the NCTE and NCERT. Other than Core courses Foundation courses and Elective course are also being offered. Value added courses are also being offered

	to enhance the skills of the students and to earn extra credits. The current syllabus of B.Ed is well structured and designed in a very latest and comprehensive way and is fairly comparable with B.Ed syllabus of any University /Institute of standard in India.
Q. 46	What are extracurricular activities conducting by the School of Education?
Ans.	School has prepared a long list of extra and co-curricular activities. These activities are conducted time to time for the development of the students. Our University also conduct various students' oriented activities through various students clubs.
Q. 47	What are the unique features of B.Ed program of Galgotias University?
Ans.	It is a well designed, comprehensively structured with latest skills and contents providing all the relevant teaching skills. We have a long and very rigorous Prepractice teaching, Practice Teaching sessions to improve the confidence, capability, competency and teaching skills of the prospective teachers. Students are kept in the schools to teach and face real students and class room situations. Four months long Internship program is organised to give deeper understanding of the working style and functioning of the schools.
Q. 48	Is there any placement system for B.Ed students?
Ans.	Galgotias group has a record of 100% placement for Engineering, Management and others professional courses. Same assurance we also give to our B.Ed students. We have separate training session to prepare an impressive Bio-Data, how to face an interview and present yourself in the schools.
Q. 49	At which time you will give us result? Is there any delay in the announcement of the result like other university system?
Ans.	No. We offer time bound B.Ed program. No delay in Practical and Theory examinations. Students will get their result in due course of time.
Q. 50	Which School method subjects I will be offered in B.Ed?
Ans.	The subjects offered by the students at the graduation and post graduation levels will form the basis for the selection of one/both teaching method/methods at B.Ed. level.
Q. 51	Which class(s) I will teach during Internship?
Ans.	B.Ed students are required to teach from class 6 to class 12 during Practice Teaching and Internship. Students possess PG degree may teach senior secondary classes in their subject(s).
Q. 52	Why should I study in your University?
