Alumnus Mr Ashish Lath of Batch 2015-18 was the speaker for the day. He is Student Support & Postgraduate Student Ambassador University of Bath - Bath, UK. Before moving to the U.K he was associated with Zomato in the role of Account Manager.</p> <p>Ms Akanksha and Ms Ankita welcomed Mr Ashish Lath and requested him to enlighten the students. He shared his journey and recalled the time when he was a student at Galgotias University. He shared the role of the faculties and co-curricular activities in personality development and growth in his life. He also started Humanities saviours foundation in Galgotias university itself.</p> <p>He mentioned that your interest is especially important, and one should choose courses based on the interest because it affects their ability to perform.
