Sports competition/Sports Day

The sports day began enthusiastically with a welcome speech by our beloved Dean Dr. Rajeev Garg. It was followed by various events lined up for the day. The two-day sports meet involved the enthusiastic participation of all the students of SOA. The students actively participated in both day events. event like Cricket and Basket Ball conducted for boys and Volley Ball were conducted for girls.

CRICKET

Cricket is a <u>bat-and-ball game</u> played between two teams of eleven players on a <u>field</u> at the center of which is a 22-yard (20-metre) <u>pitch</u> with a <u>wicket</u> at each end, each comprising two <u>bails</u> balanced on three <u>stumps</u>. The <u>batting</u> side scores <u>runs</u> by striking the <u>ball</u> bowled at the wicket with the bat (and running between the wickets), while the <u>bowling</u> and <u>fielding</u> side tries to prevent this (by preventing the ball from leaving the field, and getting the ball to either wicket) and <u>dismiss</u> each batter (so they are "out"). Means of dismissal include being <u>bowled</u>, when the ball hits the stumps and dislodges the bails, and by the fielding side either <u>catching</u> the ball after it is hit by the bat and before it hits the ground, or hitting a wicket with the ball before a batter can cross the <u>crease</u> in front of the wicket.

BASKETBALL

Basketball is a team sport in which two teams, most commonly of five players each, opposing rectangular court, with another а compete the primary objective one on of shooting a basketball (approximately 9.4 inches (24 cm) in diameter) through the defender's hoop (a basket 18 inches (46 cm) in diameter mounted 10 feet (3.048 m) high to a backboard at each end of the court) while preventing the opposing team from shooting through their own hoop. A field goal is worth two points, unless made from behind the three-point line, when it is worth three. After a foul, timed play stops and the player fouled or designated to shoot a technical foul is given one, two or three one-point free throws. The team with the most points at the end of the game wins, but if regulation play expires with the score tied, an additional period of play (overtime) is mandated.



Rules for the Basketball Tournament

The mains rules of 3x3 are as follows:

1 basket on 1 half-court.

2 teams of 3 players and up to 1 substitute per team.

12-seconds shot-clock.

1st team to reach 21 points or best after 10 minutes win.



VOLLEYBALL

Volleyball is a team sport in which two teams of six players are separated by a net. Each team tries to score points by grounding a ball on the other team's court under organized rules. The team may touch the ball up to three times, but individual players may not touch the ball twice consecutively.

The <u>complete set of rules</u> is extensive, but play essentially proceeds as follows: a player on one of the teams begins a 'rally' by serving the ball (tossing or releasing it and then hitting it with a hand or arm), from behind the back boundary line of the court, over the net, and into the receiving team's court. The receiving team must not let the ball be grounded within their court. The team may touch the ball up to three times, but individual players may not touch the ball twice consecutively. Typically, the first two touches are used to set up for an attack. An attack is an attempt to direct the ball back over the net in such a way that the team receiving the ball is unable to pass the ball and continue the rally, thus, losing the point.


