AND

Galgotias University having its Office at **Plot No. 2, Sector 17-A, Yamuna Expressway, Greater Noida, Gautam Buddh Nagar, Uttar Pradesh, India** (hereinafter referred to as "**GU**" which expression shall, unless repugnant to the context or meaning thereof, be deemed to include its representatives, nominees, successors and assigns) of the **SECOND PART**

AND WHEREAS "FWSTC" is a company-offering specialized trainings

AND WHEREAS "GU" hereby agrees to avail the services of "**FWSTC**"

AND WHEREAS "GU" appoints "**FWSTC**" as an exclusive training partner for Delhi NCR that is responsible for imparting training for a stipulated period on behalf of "**GU**"

AND WHEREAS "FWSTC" and "GU" are now willing to enter into this MOU on the terms and conditions appearing hereinafter.

IT IS HEREBY AGREED AND DEGUARED AS FOLLOWS:-

1. **APPOINTMENT**

1.1 "**FWSTC**" will offer it's training premises in Gurugram for Trainings conducted on behalf of "**GU**"

2. **SCOPE OF SERVICES**

The parties have agreed to work on the following nomenclature:

2.1 Responsible for Training candidates on behalf of "**GU**" in India as per "**FWSTC**" training standards

3. **CONSIDERATION**

3.1 It is agreed that, "**FWSTC**" and "**GU**" shall work on a revenue model for training as per **Annexure "A"**

3.2 It is agreed that all expenses like office expenditure, entertainment, travel and accommodation expenses, trainer cost and incidentals, cost for approvals, certification cost of trainer (if applicable) etc. shall be as per the **Annexure "A"**

4. **MISCELLANEOUS**

4.1 That this MOU records the complete agreement between the parties and supersedes all previous if any correspondences, understandings, letters, papers or documents

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FWSTC

5. **CONFIDENTIALITY**

5.1 The Parties agree that they shall hold in trust any confidential information of the other Party received by either Party, under this MOU, and the strictest of confidence shall be maintained in respect of such confidential information. The Parties also agree:

- (i) To maintain and use the confidential information only for the purposes of this MOU and only as permitted herein;
- (ii) To only make copies as specifically authorized by the prior written consent of the other party and with the same confidential or proprietary notices as may be printed or displayed on the original;
- (iii) To restrict access and disclosure of confidential information to such of their employees, agents, vendors, and contractors strictly on a "need to know" basis, and upon the execution of a written undertaking from such employees, agents, vendors, and contractors to maintain confidentiality of the confidential information disclosed to them in accordance with this clause 10; and
- (iv) To treat confidential information as confidential for a period of five (5) years from the date of receipt. In the event of earlier termination of this Contract, the Parties hereby agree to maintain the confidentiality of the confidential information for a further period of 2 years from the date of such termination.

5.2 Confidential information in oral form must be identified as confidential at the time of disclosure and confirmed as such in writing within thirty (30) days of such disclosure. Confidential information does not include information which:

- (i) The recipient knew or had in its possession, prior to disclosure, without limitation on its confidentiality is independently developed by the recipient without breach of this MOU information in the public domain as a matter of law is received from a third party not subject to the obligation of confidentiality with respect to such information is released from confidentiality with the written consent of the other Party.


5.3 Confidential information shall at all times remain the sole and exclusive property of the disclosing Party. Upon termination/expiry of this MOU, confidential information shall be returned to the disclosing Party or destroyed, if incapable of return. The destruction shall be witnessed and so recorded, in writing, by an authorized representative of each of the Parties.

5.4 In the event that any of the Parties hereto becomes legally compelled to disclose any confidential information, such Party shall give sufficient notice to the other Party to enable the other Party to prevent or minimize to the extent possible, such disclosure. Neither party shall disclose to a third party any confidential information or the contents of this MOU without the prior written consent of the other Party. The obligations of this clause shall be satisfied by handling confidential information with the same degree of care, which the receiving Party applies to its own similar confidential information but in no event less than reasonable care. The obligations of this clause shall survive the expiration, cancellation or termination of this MOU.

5.5 **GU or its candidates** shall not take any photograph, videos or use any technology to reproduce the Equipment or the Training Facility without the written authorization of FWSTC.

6. **NOTICES**

All notices and other communications under the MOU shall be made in writing and delivered either by hand against receipt or sent by certified or registered mail at the notified addresses of the addressee (the current addresses being set out herein). Any such notice or communication shall be deemed to have been duly given and served



(i) upon actual delivery and confirmed receipt in case of hand delivery, or (ii) on the third day of the putting the notice/communication in the course of transmission if sent via certified or registered mail.

Any modification in this memorandum of understanding during its tenure or at the time of renewal shall only be through mutual MOU and duly signed by the authorized representatives of the "FWSTC" and "GU"

This MOU shall take effect, upon mutual consent of both PARTIES, from **24th October 2018** and shall remain in effect for an initial term of **3** Years with a lock in period of 1 Year. Thereafter, it will be renewed annually, on such terms as mutually agreed upon by both the parties.


However, either of the parties shall have the option to terminate the MOU in writing by serving 6 (calendar months) notice on the other PARTY

Without prejudice to the generality of the foregoing paragraph, GU shall indemnify, defend and hold harmless FWSTC and its officers, directors, employees and agents from and against all damages, losses and causes of action caused by bodily injury to or death of any person (whether employee, personnel or guest of FWSTC or the Student, or any third party) due to any accident caused by, or negligence of Students or any personnel/agent deployed by GU pursuant to this MOU.

AND WHEREAS "FWSTC" is a company-offering specialized trainings

AND WHEREAS "GU" hereby agrees to avail the services of "FWSTC"

AND WHEREAS "GU" appoints "FWSTC" as an exclusive training partner for Delhi NCR that is responsible for imparting training for a stipulated period on behalf of "GU"

3.1 University shall be responsible to bring the training candidates/students for the Program.

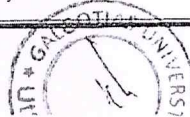
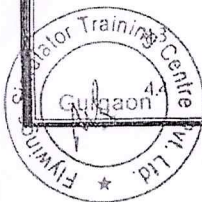

- c. The University represents and warrants that it shall provide the Program in full compliance with the rules and regulations of the relevant regulatory and statutory bodies and all applicable laws.

8. CONFIDENTIALITY

10. FORCE MAJEURE

10.1 Any non-performance or delay in performance by either Party of any of its duties, obligations, or responsibilities under this MOU, shall be excused if, and to the extent that such non-performance or delay in performance is caused by Force Majeure.

10.2 Force Majeure shall mean the following events and circumstances to the extent that they, or their consequences, have an effect described herein:

- i. acts of God, including without limitation fire, storms, floods, earthquake or lightning, pandemic, epidemic
- ii. war, hostilities, terrorist acts, riots, civil commotion or disturbances, change in governmental laws, orders or regulations adversely affecting or preventing due performance by either Party of its duties, obligations or responsibilities under this Agreement, embargoes, actions by a government, central or state in India or overseas, or an agency thereof, sabotage or explosions, strikes, lockouts, or other concerted industrial action; or
- iii. any such other acts, occurrences, events, or circumstances beyond the reasonable control of the Party affected.

10.3 If such Force Majeure as aforesaid continues for an uninterrupted period exceeding 60 (sixty) Business Days, the Parties shall meet forthwith to discuss the consequences of the Force Majeure and the course of action to be taken to mitigate the effects thereof or to be adopted in the circumstances.

11. TERM & TERMINATION

11.1 This MOU shall take effect, upon mutual consent of both PARTIES, from the effective date ("Term") and shall remain in effect for an initial term of 3 Years. Thereafter, it will be renewed annually, on such terms as mutually agreed upon by both the parties.

11.2 Either of the parties shall have the option to terminate the MOU without cause in writing by serving 30 days' written notice on the other PARTY. In the event of such termination, all payments due to FWSTC shall be paid by GU up to the date of termination.



11.3 Any termination of the MOU for any reason whatsoever after the commencement of the training program for a Batch shall be without prejudice to and without any adverse effect on such Batch and the Parties shall act in good faith to ensure the successful continuance of the Program until the expiry of the tenure for such a Batch. Subject to the continuation of its services for such a Batch, FWSTC shall be entitled to the payment of fees as per Annexure A.

11.4 In the event FWSTC ceases to administer the program for a particular batch while the program is ongoing, Pro rata fees to the extent that services are not provided by FWSTC shall be refunded to GU within 14 days and the University shall not be liable to pay any fees to FWSTC.

11.5 Termination on Default: This MOU may be terminated (i) immediately by a written notice by the non-defaulting Party in the event the other Party commits a material breach of the MOU and is unable to rectify it the said material breach within 15 days of having received a written notice; or (ii) if the other Party files for or is placed into bankruptcy, liquidation or company reorganization processing or such other proceedings having similar effect; or (iii) if a receiver is appointed over any part of such other Party's business or if an administration order is made in respect of such other Party.

It is clarified, for the avoidance of doubts that in the event the Parties are unable to reach an agreement for renewing this MOU or the Parties mutually agree to not renew this MOU for any term beyond the Term specified, this MOU shall stand terminated at the end of the Term.

12. Two Original Copies of this MOU have been prepared, one to be retained by "FWSTC" and other to be retained by "GU"

13. **GOVERNING LAW AND JURISDICTION**

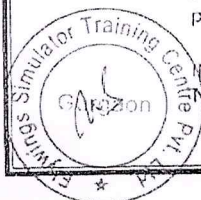

14.2 Without prejudice to the foregoing paragraph, GU shall indemnify, defend and hold harmless FWSTC and its officers, directors, employees and agents from and against all damages, losses and causes of action caused by bodily injury, to or by or to any person (whether employee, personnel or guest of FWSTC or the student or any other party) due to any accident caused by or negligence of student or any personnel/agent deployed by GU pursuant to this MOU.

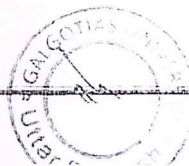
