GALGOTIAS UNIVERSITY, GREATER NOIDA





“Yatharth Hospital, Greater Noida” Referred as first party and “School of Basic and Applied Sciences, Galgotias University” Referred as second Party are exchanging this agreement to develop a spirit of academic as well as industrial co-operation with each other.

1. This agreement aims to promote academic co-operation and to give industrial exposure and research experiences between “School of Basic and Applied Sciences, Galgotias University” (SBAS, GU) and “Yatharth Hospital” (YATHARTH HOSPITAL, GREATER NOIDA). The two organizations will cooperate in developing mutual interests on a reciprocal basis of respect for the independence and equal status of each organization.
2. The two organizations agree to:
 - a. Provide industrial exposure to students (As per the availability by the first party);
3. The details of this agreement are to be decided by mutual consultation between the two Institutions. Both parties understand that all terms and conditions of the above-mentioned activities as well as there is no financial commitment. If there is any financial consideration, it will be dealt separately.
4. Yatharth Hospital, Greater Noida, shall provide Training/Internship to students of the “School of Basic and Applied Sciences, Galgotias University in their areas of specialization.
5. YATHARTH HOSPITAL, GREATER NOIDA shall provide necessary laboratory facilities as per terms and condition, norms and fee structure of YATHARTH HOSPITAL, GREATER NOIDA from time to time.
6. This agreement shall be in effect for two years from the date of signature and automatically extended for the same period if written intent of termination by either party is not presented six months before the date of expiration.
7. Both parties believe that close co-operation between the two would be a major benefit to the student community to enhance their skills and knowledge.
8. Any specific programs will be subject to mutual consent, availability of funds and approval of both parties.

9. Both parties may nominate appropriate people to coordinate the development and implementation of any specific program or activity to be conducted under this memorandum of understanding (MoU). The contact details may be amended as required without affecting the intent and purpose of the MoU as a whole.
10. The parties agree that this MoU is not a formal legal agreement giving rise to any legal relationship, rights, duties or consequences, but is only a definite expression and record of the purpose of the parties to which the parties are bound in honour only.
11. Both parties agrees to take measures to prevent any unauthorized use or disclosure of personal information collected or accessed in connection with this MoU and will have in place documented policies and procedures, which will be regularly reviewed, tested and updated, as appropriate, encompassing the administrative, physical and technical safeguards in place and relevant to the access, use, loss, alteration, disclosure, storage, destruction and control of information, and to comply with applicable privacy laws.
12. The Yatharth Hospital will give on the job training to the students on the emerging technologies in order to bridge the gap in skill and make them ready for industry.
13. The Yatharth Hospital will extend the necessary support to deliver guest lecturers to the students on the technology trends and in-house requirements.
14. This agreement is executed in English in two original, and each Institute will retain one original.



