Agenda 1. Welcome by member secretary

- Dean PG & Ph.D. Dr Naresh Kumar, welcomed the Honourable Vice Chancellor, Dr.Preeti Bajaj (Chairman of RAC), external and internal members of RAC. Vice Chancellor introduced members to the house and welcomed them to first meeting of RAC 2019-20
- Dr Balamurugan Chief Research Coordinator briefly presented the salient achievements toward Research activities at Galgotias University.
- Member Secretary presented following agenda points.

2. Points for Ratification

(A) Ph.D. Regulations 2019-2020

Member secretary presented the highlights of Ph.D regulations 2019-20

(A.1) Supervisor and Co-Supervisor allocation

- Suggestion was given by Prof. Milind Atrey to make Assistant/Associate professor (if eligible) as Supervisor and professor as Co-Supervisor.
- Prof. Bhim Singh suggested one PhD scholar can be allocated at the time of joining. Every Year one student can be allocated if eligible.
- Chairman Dr Preeti Bajaj discusses the process of making the Guide as co-guide, when anyone leaves the university.

(A.2) Research Fellowship.

- On enquiry from experts RAC chairman proposed scholarship for full time PhD scholars from 2019-20 session.
- Prof. Bhim Singh suggested scholars getting scholarship should conduct only lab work or tutorial o 8 hours per week.

(A.3) Performance monitoring was discussed.

- Professor Milind Atrey enquired about monitoring and performance of PhD scholars and suggested PhD Progress presentation must be conducted every 6 months.
- PhD scholars, if not done two progress presentations in a satisfactory manner need to be give warning and after third unsatisfactory progress presentation admission will be cancelled.

(A.4) Course Credit Requirements and Registration for Courses.



- Ph.D scholars with prior permission to be given flexibility to take the same courses under coursework from other nearby premier universities (like CTS).
- There should be a course with the departmental perspective.
- PhD Scholars can do additional course to increase the CGPA.
- Case of PhD Scholar from industry is discussed and guidelines were framed as the scholar not having a PG degree in the relevant stream of Research. Some additional course can be given in addition to 18 credits, which are core courses of the stream in which he/she wish to do PhD. After then only enrolment is to be done. Also NOC from the industry in which scholar is working to be sought.

(A.6) Registration date

- Provisional registration needs to be done before course work and then after the completion of course work permanent registration needs to be done but minimum duration for completion of PhD should remain as 3 year including course work.

Resolutions 2A/1 :

PhD regulations 2019-20 approve with following additions:

- Assistant/Associate professor can be Supervisor and professor can be Co-Supervisor.
- One PhD scholar can be allocated at the time of joining (if eligible for guidance) another after semester/year.
- Full time scholars will be paid stipend of Rs 15,000 per month provided they will take load of Lectures and tutorials 8 Hrs per week.
- Every six month student have to present their progress in PhD colloquia.
- If two presentations will be unsatisfactory then the students will be issued warning.
- After warning one more unsatisfactory presentation will liable to cancellation of registration of scholar.
- If course work subjects are not being conducted in the university, Ph.D scholars can be give flexibility to take the same from other nearby premier universities (with prior permission) however may vary from case to case.
- Case of Ph.D Scholar from industry is discussed and guidelines were framed as the scholar not having a PG degree in the relevant stream of research .The solution was to give two more courses in addition to 18 credit course.



- Final registration will be only after the completion of course work before that provisional registration is to be done by the scholar but minimum duration for completion of Ph.D degree shall remain as 3 years.

Resolution 2B/1 :

- PhD supervisors list attached as annexure III is approved.

3. Points for Discussion & Approval.

(a) Old enrolled candidates to be regulated by 2014/2019

- Old Ph.D regulations need to be followed for old students if they have completed their course work and at least two DC meetings (with max extension of 1 year).
- Prof Bhim Singh and Prof Milind Atrey suggested that old students are regulated by GU regulations 2014 shall be given additional one more year to complete their research work on the completion of maximum prescribed period of (3+2) years. After that students have to apply for re-registration and shall be regulated by New PhD policy winter 2019-20 regulations.

(b) R&D Policy (Annexure-II)

- Professor Bhim Singh suggested citations incentive can be divided for Rs.5000 for 50 citations per year and Rs. 10000 for 1000 citations per year.

(c) Confirmation of SRC recommendations.

(d) Thesis Evaluation Norms.

- For PhD thesis evaluation, One examiner will be from outside the country and two within the country (outside NCR). If two examiners reviews are positive, viva can be conducted in any one examiner presence. Skype presence is allowed for examiner for final viva .

(e) The candidates who have completed 5 years

- PhD scholars registered for PhD more than 5 years needs to inform through email from university and encouraged by giving one additional year for completing their thesis. If they are not able to complete they shall be considered under re-registration.



Resolution 3/1:

- Old PhD regulations need to be followed for old students (if no re-registration).
- Citations incentive can be divided for Rs.5000 for 50 citations per year and Rs. 10000 for 1000 citations per year
- All SRC recommendations presented are approved.
- For PhD thesis evaluation, One examiner will be from outside the country and two within the country (outside state). If any two examiners reviews were positive, viva can be conducted. Skype presence is allowed for examiner for final viva.
- Extension will be given to all scholars provided case by case approval from Vice Chancellor.

4. Any other item

- An IPR policy for Galgotias University needs to be framed.
- Patent ownership policy needs to be framed before filling of patent.
- All present and new industry candidates have to submit NOC from their organization that organization will provide administrative support to them.
- All deans are advised to write project proposals for DST/other funding agencies.

Resolution 4/1:

- All points in the discussion are approved with no changes.
