A. Inclusive Mobility on Campus

The key initiatives and features that reflect our dedication to inclusive mobility on campus:

- 1) **Accessible Infrastructure:** Our campus facilities, including classrooms, dormitories, libraries, and recreational areas, have been designed and constructed with accessibility in mind. This includes ramps, elevators, and other features to make all areas of the campus reachable for individuals with mobility challenges.
- 2) **Transportation:** We provide accessible transportation options within the campus, ensuring that everyone can easily move around the premises. Our sidewalks and pathways are well-maintained and designed to accommodate wheelchairs and other mobility aids.

TRANSPORTATION FACILITIES



Galgotias University provides a dedicated bus service to meet the challenge of transportation for all its students, faculty and staff members. Galgotias University places a high premium on the safety, hygiene and punctuality of its transport system. The university takes great pains to ensure these key factors, and has appointed dedicated members to monitor the performance of the service. In addition to this, the university has a fleet of cars and vans for backup transport.

When students are required to stay back late for training, workshops, extra-curricular activities or organizational activities, the university ensures that their transportation needs are taken care of, by this fleet. The university buses ply on the following routes at a designated time and students and staff members are ferried to and from there:

1. **Curb Ramps and Crosswalks:** We have installed curb ramps at intersections and crosswalks to facilitate smooth transit for individuals using wheelchairs, walkers, or other mobility aids. These ramps are designed to meet accessibility standards and ensure a gentle slope for easy navigation.

2. **Accessible Sidewalks:** Our sidewalks are constructed to be wide, level, and free of obstacles, allowing unobstructed passage for individuals with mobility challenges. Tactile paving is used to guide those with visual impairments.

C. The classroom seating at Galgotias University is thoughtfully designed to ensure that it reasonably accommodates the diverse needs of students, considering both varied learning styles and the requirements of persons with disabilities.

D. Adequate maneuvering space for wheelchairs:

Galgotias University provides a truly inclusive learning environment and one of our key initiatives in this regard is to ensure that the aisles within classrooms are designed to allow adequate maneuvering space for wheelchairs. This commitment reflects our strong belief in creating a campus that is accessible to all, catering not only to the diverse learning styles of our students but also to the specific needs of individuals with disabilities.



E. Galgotias University is committed to ensuring that every student, including those with hearing impairments, has equal access to quality education. In our large classrooms and lecture theaters, we recognize the importance of using appropriate technologies for sound emission, such as advanced speaker systems and microphones. 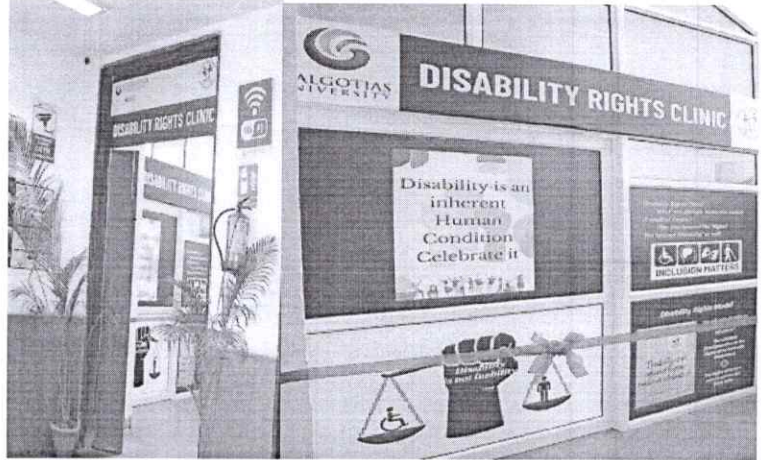
