Application

This Policy applies to all individuals below the poverty line within the university community, including students, faculty, and staff. The policy aims to adapt to the population's evolving needs and reflect current socio-economic conditions.

Purpose

- To address and mitigate poverty within the university, ensuring that steps taken are effective, inclusive, and address the unique needs of the university's population.
- It focuses on equitable access to education, resources, and opportunities for those who are economically disadvantaged.
- The policy will undergo regular evaluation to assess the effectiveness of strategies and will be updated based on emerging challenges and opportunities.

Policy Statement

The university is committed to reducing poverty within its community. It aims to involve all stakeholders students, faculty, staff, and local communities in the development, implementation, and ongoing assessment of this policy to ensure its success in alleviating poverty.

1. Financial Aid Programs

Establishment of need-based scholarships, grants, and loan programs specifically targeting students from economically disadvantaged backgrounds.

Introduction of low-interest or no-interest loans with flexible repayment terms for students in need.

Transparent and accessible financial aid application processes to ensure ease of access.

Annual review and adjustment of financial aid offerings to keep pace with inflation, changing economic conditions, and students' evolving needs.

2. Work-Study Opportunities

Expansion of on-campus and off-campus work-study programs that allow students to earn money while gaining relevant work experience.

Collaborate with local and international businesses for off-campus work-study opportunities, allowing students to build professional networks.

Promote paid internship opportunities as part of academic programs to reduce financial strain and provide career-building experiences.

3. Community Outreach and Partnerships

Strengthen collaborations with local communities, non-governmental organizations (NGOs), and government agencies to identify and support students in need.

Establish a university-led network of local businesses for internships, job placements, and mentorships, ensuring post-graduation employment opportunities.

Engage in corporate social responsibility (CSR) initiatives and partner with businesses to fund and create scholarships and employment pathways for underprivileged students.

4. Skill Development and Training

9. Faculty and Staff Training

Provide training for faculty and staff to increase awareness of the challenges faced by economically disadvantaged students.

Foster a supportive environment where faculty and staff can offer both academic and emotional support to those in need.

10. Advocacy and Awareness

Advocate for policies at the state, national, and international levels that promote higher education accessibility for economically disadvantaged students.

Raise awareness within the university community about poverty, inequality, and opportunities for systemic change.

11. Graduation/Completion Targets for Economically Disadvantaged Students

The university has specific targets of graduation/completion set for those falling into the bottom 20% of household income groups in the country.

These targets ensure that students coming from economically disadvantaged backgrounds get all the support and resources required to complete their education successfully. This will therefore enhance upward mobility and success opportunities.

12. Support for Students from Low-Income Families

There is support in different forms at the university level for the poor, including food, accommodation, transportation, and legal services. These measures aim to ensure students are relieved of the pressures from their basic needs so they can concentrate on their academics.

13. Support for Students from Low or Lower-Middle Income Countries

Galgotias University has taken initiatives that help students from low or lower-middle-income countries, by providing free education and grants, among other things. This ensures that the students from these backgrounds get equal opportunities to succeed and complete their studies at the university, furthering the commitment of the institution toward global equity in education.

Scholarships

Galgotias University is committed to recognizing and rewarding excellence across diverse domains. We offer a comprehensive range of scholarships to outstanding candidates based on their remarkable achievements in academics, extracurricular activities, and various competitive examinations. Whether it's exceptional performance in Board exams like 10+2, Diploma or Graduation, securing top ranks in prestigious All India/State Level Entrance Tests, or demonstrating exceptional talents in sports, or any other field of endeavour, Galgotias University celebrates and supports students who have excelled in their chosen areas of expertise. Our scholarships aim to nurture and empower these gifted individuals, providing them with the resources and opportunities to further hone their skills and reach new heights of success.

Merit Scholarship at the time of Admission

1.1 Grant of Admission Merit-Scholarship

The scholarships to be awarded will be announced through Admission Notifications that are issued to the public at various times during the year.

1.2 Amount of Scholarship

1.2.1 Academic Brilliance Scholarship

- 100% tuition fee waiver as scholarship to the topper (1st Position) of all central and state Boards.
- 25% tuition fee waiver*as scholarship for students securing 95% or above in class 12th (except B.Pharm and B.Sc Nursing Program)
- 15% tuition fee waiver*as scholarship for students securing 90-94.99% in class 12th. (except B.Pharm and B.Sc Nursing Program)
- 100% tuition fee waiver as scholarship to the topper (1st position) of all university.
- 25% tuition fee waiver as scholarship for students having minimum 90% marks or above in graduation.
- 15% tuition fee waiver as scholarship for students having minimum 80-89.99% marks in graduation.

1.2.2 Entrance Examination Scholarship

- 50% tuition fee waiver as scholarship for students securing up to 25000th rank in the JEE Examination.
- 20% tuition fee waiver as scholarship for students securing minimum 60%ile in CAT, or above 600 marks in MAT.
- 20% tuition fee waiver as scholarship for meritorious LSAT qualified students.

^{*}This scholarship is subject to the program eligibility criteria mentioned on the website.

- 20% tuition fee waiver as scholarship for the student securing minimum 100 score in CLAT exam.
- 5% tuition fee waiver as scholarship for students who have chosen GU as their university preference in CUET (Common University Entrance Test).

1.2.3 Ex-Student/Alumni/Old Student Scholarship

10% tuition fee waiver as a scholarship for Ex-Student/Alumni/old student of Galgotias University obtaining admission to higher studies, provided the applicant must have secured a CGPA of 6.0 or more in their qualifying degree/diploma (without any back paper).

In case of gap is more than 3 years between the qualifying exam & seeking admission in Galgotias University, this scholarship will not be granted.

Note: No Application for On-Admission Scholarship (Clause 1.1, 1.2 & 1.3) will be entertained after the last date of admission.

1.2.4 Procedure of Grant of Admission Merit Scholarship

The scholarship will be awarded at the time of admission. The admission department must obtain prior approval from the appropriate authority for granting the scholarship under the specified category, as well as the prescribed level of marks, percentage, percentile, or grades. The department will then verify the mark sheets to determine the category under which the student qualifies for the scholarship.

1.3 Continuation of on Admission Merit-Scholarship

A student will be eligible to get the Scholarship of 10% for the next year(s) if he/she is able to maintain a CGPA of 9.0 or above, has no backlog of carry-over papers at the end of the previous year, and maintains a minimum attendance of 75%.

1.3.1 Procedure for Grant of Continuation of Admission Merit Scholarship

The scholarships will be continued on the Application form submitted by the student along with the verified copies of results by the controller of examination if the student fulfil the conditions prescribed in clause 1.3.

1.3.2 Discontinuation of Admission Merit-Scholarship

The scholarship shall be discontinued at any time during a programme, from the date as directed by the Vice Chancellor, under the following conditions

- A. The student is not able to meet the Academic performance as prescribed in clause (1.3).
- B. The student is unable to pass all the examinations in the first attempt in the normal examination scheduled for his/her programme. The student has engaged in unfair means in examinations or has been debarred from appearing in the examinations.

C. If the HOD/Dean reports that the student has engaged in misconduct, misbehaviour, gross indiscipline, ragging, use of drugs or narcotics and the charges havebeen established or found in any activity which breaks the Student Code of Conduct.

Scholarship once discontinued will be restored when the student has raised his/her CGPA to 9.0 or above, has cleared all back papers, and maintains a minimum attendance of 75%.

Note: If the student falls in condition C, the scholarship will not be continued.

Scholarship Process

- **Step 1:** Application Submit the Application form
- **Step 2:** Documentation In the Application form Upload/Submit all prerequisite Documents (Upload latest 3 Years Sports Certificates)
- Step 3: Notification Successful applicants will be notified for sports trials via email/ Call.
- **Step 4:** One to One Interaction + Skills Assessment/Sports Trial
- **Step 5:** Scholarship Selection + Disbursal

Scholarship Application Process

- Once a student fills the form, The sports department will intimate the details (date, time and venue) pertaining to sports trials.
- Scholarship applicants can obtain the Scholarship Application form from the Admissions Office OR applicant can apply online at www.galgotiasuniversity.edu.in
- The duly filled scholarship application form should be submitted at the Admissions Office.
- Consideration will be given to applications that meet the eligibility criteria for each scholarship category provided the application is received before the specified deadline.
- Applications for Scholarships received after the last date will not be considered.

Scholarship Disbursal Criteria

Eligibility Criteria

- 1. Applicant must be Indian Citizen.
- 2. Latest 3 years certificates will be considered for the evaluation.
- 3. Sports Certificate of Invitational/Memorial/Open/Prize Money League/Ranking competitions will not be considered.
- 4. Only the highest Sports Certificate will be considered for Marking.
- 5. Candidate must pass the physical fitness and a sports proficiency test.
- 6. Scholarship Test and Interview (If Applicable).

- 7. The Galgotias University sports scholarship evaluation is based on a total of 100 marks, consisting of two components:
 - a) Sports Certificates (Maximum 40 marks, Minimum 14 marks required)
 - b) Sports Trials (60 marks, Minimum 50% or 30 marks required to qualify)

To qualify for the sports scholarship, candidates must secure a minimum of 14 marks in the Sports Certificates component and a minimum of 30 marks (50%) in the Sports Trials component.

Merit-Scholarships for High Performers

To encourage students to achieve higher performance during their studies in an academic programme, the University has instituted Merit scholarships to recognize their academic achievements.

These scholarships will be awarded every year to second, third, fourth and fifth year students after the declaration of the results of winter semester of the previous year. This scholarship will be for a period of one year duration.

4.1 Merit Scholarships

At the end of each academic year, a merit list consisting of the first second and third rankers in each batch and programme of study will be prepared on the basis of CGPA for consideration for merit scholarships.

To receive favourable consideration for any merit scholarship, the student should have passed all the examinations in the first attempt. The number of Merit Scholarships will be determined as follows.

The amount of Merit Scholarship during the programme will be equal to 30% of the tuition fee payable by the student in the subsequent year and will be rounded off to next multiple of Rs.100/-.

4.3 Procedure for Grant of Scholarship

The Merit scholarship will be granted for the subsequent year of study and will be adjusted in the next installment of fees to be paid.

4.4 Discontinuation of Merit Scholarship

The scholarship shall be discontinued at any time during a programme, with effect from the date as approved by the Vice Chancellor, under the following conditions:

- a) The student has been found to engage in unfair practices in examinations or has been debarred from appearing in the examinations for any valid reason.
- b) If the Head of the Department reports that the student has been charged with misconduct, misbehavior, gross indiscipline, incident of ragging, use of drugs or narcotics and the charges have been established or found in any activity which breaks the Student Code of Conduct

Under this scheme, the state government provides education loan of upto Rs. 4 Lakh to secondary or senior secondary passout students.

Steps to Apply for Bihar Students Credit Card Scheme

The students who are eligible for this scheme can apply through online portal. Following are the steps to apply online for this scheme.

- Step 1. Visit website https://www.7nishchay-yuvaupmission.bihar.gov.in/
- Step 2. Register as new user.
- Step 3. Fill the basic details.
- Step 4. Student will receive an OTP (One Time Password) on registered number and email id.
- Step 5. After entering the OTP, a new form will open where the student will have to submit personal details.
- Step 6. After submitting personal details, 3 options will appear.
- Step 7. Select the student credit card from the 3 option and fill details in new form.

West Bengal Students Credit Card Scheme

The Higher Education Department, Government of West Bengal has introduced the Student Credit Card Scheme for the students of West Bengal to enable them to pursue education without having any financial constraints. This scheme is designed to support the students to pursue secondary, higher secondary, madrasah, undergraduate and post graduate studies including professional degree and other equivalent courses in any School, Madrasah, College, University and other affiliated institutes within and outside India.
