4. Event Detailed Description –

The NSS Unit - 1 organized an awareness campaign on “Jal Mahotsav” under the initiative of the Ministry of Jal Shakti at Village Junedpur, Dhankaur, Greater Noida, Uttar Pradesh. The primary objective of the event was to spread awareness about water conservation, sustainable usage of water resources, and the importance of preserving water for future generations.

The campaign began with a poster-making activity in which NSS volunteers actively participated. Volunteers creatively designed informative and visually appealing posters highlighting key messages mainly in Hindi Language for the
