Beyond Borders: Exploring Master’s Opportunities at Birmingham



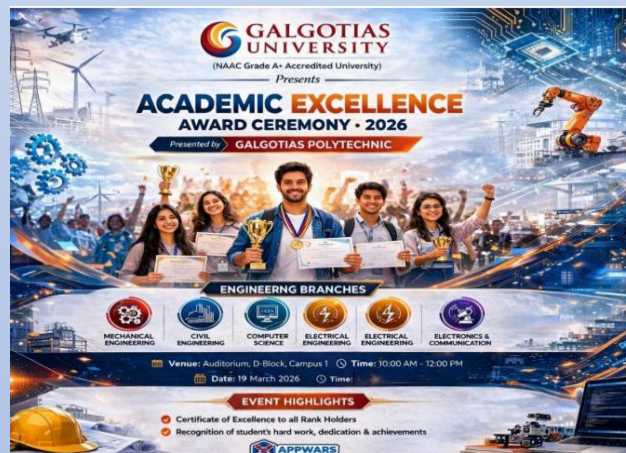

From Classroom to Industry: Building Skills for Manufacturing Excellence



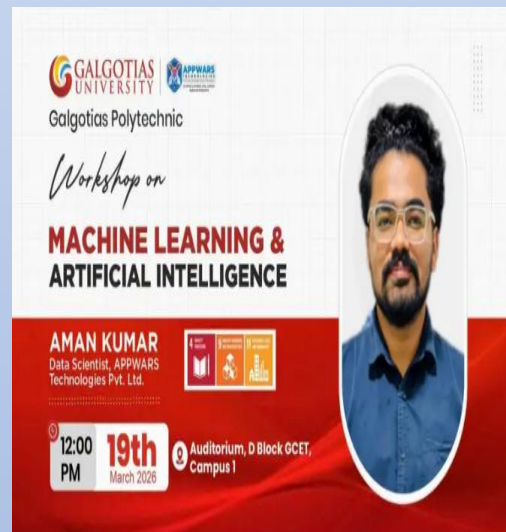

From Data to Discovery: Empowering Students with AI & ML

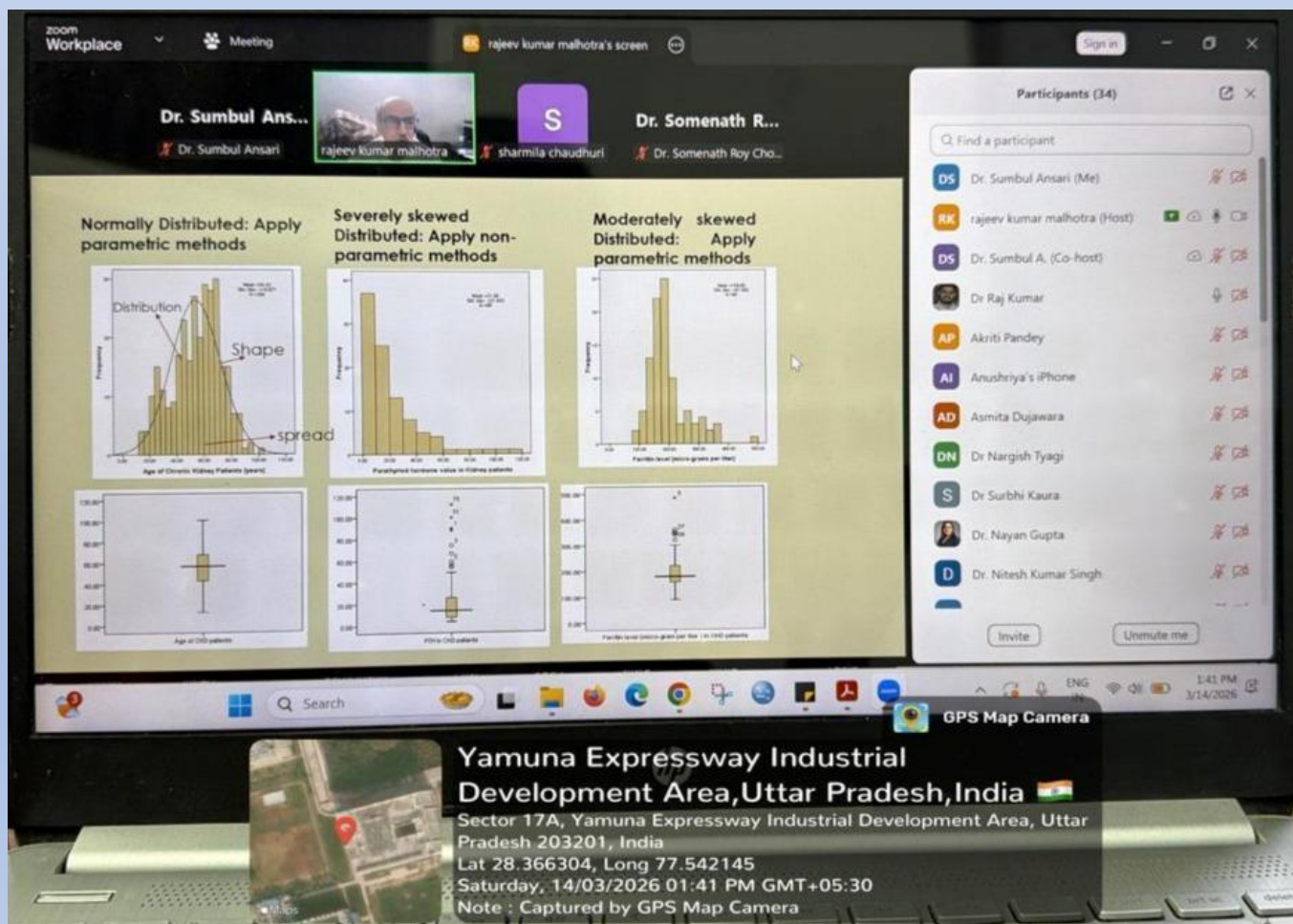

Mr. Aman Kumar, Data Scientist at APPWARS Technologies Pvt. Ltd., provided practical insights into machine learning algorithms, supervised and unsupervised learning, and real-world AI applications. Case studies demonstrated AI applications in healthcare, smart cities, and industrial automation. The interactive session also addressed ethical considerations, data privacy, career opportunities, and project ideas. The workshop encouraged students to explore emerging technologies, strengthen critical thinking, and apply AI concepts to academic projects and research.
