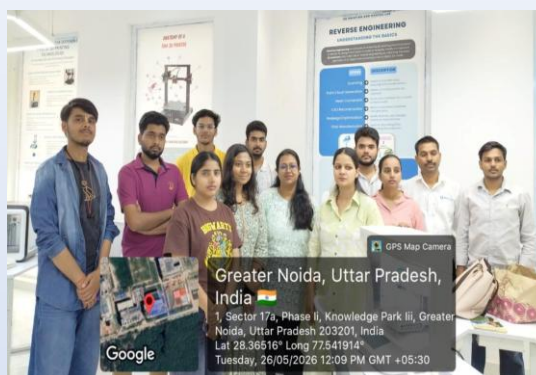


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Printing the Future: Advancing Biomedical Innovation through 3D Bioprinting



On 26 May 2026, the Department of Biotechnology & Bioengineering, School of Biosciences & Technology, in collaboration with the Institution's Innovation Council (IIC), Galgotias University, organized a workshop on "Cellink 3D Bioprinting and Live Demonstration." The session provided students with practical exposure to advanced 3D bioprinting technologies and their applications in biomedical engineering, regenerative medicine, and tissue engineering. Experts demonstrated Cellink 3D bioprinting systems, biomaterial handling, scaffold fabrication, and live bioprinting procedures. Interactive discussions explored tissue modelling and emerging healthcare applications. Faculty guidance further highlighted research opportunities and industrial prospects, encouraging innovation-driven learning, technical awareness, and research-oriented thinking.

Advancing Biosciences: Innovation, Research and Healthcare Beyond Boundaries



On 7 May 2026, Galgotias University organized the International Conference on Innovations in Biosciences and Health Care (ICIBHC-2026) at Vivekanand Auditorium, Greater Noida. The conference brought together researchers, academicians, healthcare professionals, industry experts, and students to explore emerging developments in biosciences and healthcare technologies. Keynote lectures, invited talks, poster presentations, model exhibitions, and scientific discussions highlighted biotechnology, translational medicine, cancer therapeutics, biomaterials, immunotherapy, and precision healthcare. Experts from India, USA, and South Korea shared insights on healthcare innovations and translational research. With 144 participants, 139 posters, and 15 models, the conference strengthened scientific exchange, networking, interdisciplinary collaboration, and research-oriented learning.

Beyond Classrooms: Exploring Genomics, Research and Biotechnology Innovation



On 15 May 2026, the Department of Biotechnology & Bioengineering, School of Biosciences & Technology, in association with the Institution's Innovation Council (IIC), organized an industrial visit to the Institute of Genomics and Integrative Biology (IGIB), New Delhi. A total of 59 students and five faculty members participated enthusiastically. Participants explored advanced research facilities, modern instrumentation, and ongoing projects in genomics, molecular biology, bioinformatics, and healthcare technologies. Scientists and research experts shared insights into interdisciplinary research, emerging biotechnology trends, and career opportunities. The visit strengthened students' understanding of real-world research environments while promoting experiential learning, scientific curiosity, innovation, and academic-industry interaction.

Advancing Healthcare Through Innovation, Research and Global Collaboration



On 7 May 2026, Galgotias University organized the International Conference on Innovation in Biosciences and Health Care (ICIBHC 2026) at Vivekanand Auditorium, bringing together scientists, academicians, researchers, healthcare professionals, and students from India and abroad. Keynote and invited lectures explored translational research, cancer biology, immunotherapy, liquid biopsy, biomaterials, non-ionizing radiation, and emerging healthcare technologies. Poster and experimental model presentations provided young researchers opportunities to showcase innovative work and engage in scientific exchange. Distinguished speakers from India, the USA, and South Korea enriched interdisciplinary discussions.

From Genomes to Healthcare: Exploring the Future of Biomedical Research



The Department of Biomedical Sciences, School of Biosciences and Technology, Galgotias University, organized an educational and research-oriented visit to CSIR–Institute of Genomics and Integrative Biology (CSIR-IGIB), New Delhi. Accompanied by Dr. Charu Gupta and Dr. Hima Baruah, students explored advanced facilities and technologies including Next-Generation Sequencing, molecular diagnostics, bioinformatics, computational biology, and genomic analysis. Interactive sessions with scientists provided insights into genomics, precision medicine, cancer biology, infectious diseases, and translational research. The visit bridged classroom learning with real-world scientific applications, strengthening research aptitude, innovation, scientific awareness, and career motivation.

On 31 May 2026, the School of Finance and Commerce, Galgotias University, organized an online workshop titled “A Workshop on Qualitative and Quantitative Research.” Dr. Disha Rani Yadav, Assistant Professor, Department of Commerce, Pt. Sundarlal Sharma (Open) University, Bilaspur, Chhattisgarh, served as the resource person. The session provided participants with practical insights into research problem identification, objective formulation, methodology selection, and research design. Qualitative techniques including interviews, focus groups, case studies, and thematic analysis, alongside quantitative methods such as surveys, hypothesis testing, and statistical analysis, were discussed. Ethical considerations, data collection, validity, reliability, and research applications were also highlighted, enhancing participants’ research capabilities and academic preparedness.

“ Navigating Uncertainty: West Asian Geopolitics and Global Supply Chains



On 4 May 2026, a guest lecture on “Impact of West Asian Geopolitics on Global Supply Chains” was organized to enhance students’ understanding of geopolitical influences on global trade, transportation, logistics, and supply chain networks. The session explored West Asia’s strategic importance as a hub for energy resources, maritime routes, and international commerce. Discussions focused on regional conflicts, diplomatic relations, trade sanctions, security concerns, and their implications for the movement of goods and services. Students gained insights into challenges faced by airlines, shipping companies, logistics providers, and multinational corporations. The lecture also highlighted strategies for developing resilient and sustainable supply chains amid geopolitical uncertainties.
