registered, government-recognized, non-profit, non-political, secular, and public charitable organization. It works with underprivileged children to provide them with education, healthcare, and protection from exploitation, enabling them to pursue and complete schooling.

To sensitize the youth and inculcate the values of empathy and compassion, the School of Education, Galgotias University organized a community visit on 31 August 2025 for the B.Ed. and M.Ed. third-semester students. The students also interacted with the founder of Pehchaan: The Street School, who shared his journey of community service. He inspired the future teachers with the message that educators must not only impart knowledge but also act as guides, humanitarians, and contributors to society. His words emphasized the importance of teachers becoming a source of hope and service for the community.

The visit proved to be a valuable experience for the B.Ed. and M.Ed. students, instilling in them a deeper understanding of social responsibility, empathy, and the role of teachers beyond classrooms. This visit aligns with Sustainable Development Goal (SDG) 4 Quality Education.
