1. Entrance Examination Process

The Entrance Examination will be conducted in two phases:

- Written Test
- Interview

Declaration of Results:

- Candidates who qualify in the Written Test will be invited for the Interview phase.
- The list of shortlisted will be published on the official website.

Exemption from Written Test:

Candidates who meet any of the following criteria are exempted from the Written Test:

- Qualified NET / SLET / GATE or an equivalent national-level examination.
- Possess a minimum of 10 years of relevant work experience in the respective field.

Final Result Declaration and Admission Process

- The final results will be published on the official website.
- Admissions will be conducted at the Admission Office.
- An offer letter will be issued to the selected candidates
