Description (min 150 to max 800 words) *	The Department of Pharmacy, School of Medical & Allied Sciences (SMAS), Galgotias University, organized an expert lecture on “Industry Roles: R&D, Regulatory Affairs and Clinical Research” on 10th February 2026 from 10:00 AM to 12:00 PM. The session aimed to provide students with valuable insights into diverse career opportunities and professional responsibilities within the pharmaceutical and healthcare industries. The expert speaker for the session was Dr. Harmeet Goel, Head of Department, Preventive Oncology, who shared her extensive experience and knowledge regarding the evolving landscape of pharmaceutical research and healthcare. The lecture was attended by undergraduate, postgraduate, and research students, along with faculty members from the Department of Pharmacy. During the session, Dr. Goel highlighted the significance of Research and Development (R&D) in the discovery and development of innovative medicines and healthcare solutions. She explained the various stages involved in drug development, including preclinical studies, formulation development, clinical trials, and post-marketing surveillance. The students gained an understanding of how scientific innovation drives advancements in patient care and treatment outcomes. The speaker also discussed the crucial role of Regulatory Affairs professionals in ensuring compliance with national and international regulatory guidelines. She elaborated on the processes involved in drug approvals, dossier preparation, documentation, quality standards, and interactions with regulatory authorities. Furthermore, she emphasized the growing demand for skilled regulatory professionals in the pharmaceutical sector. A major focus of the lecture was on Clinical Research, where Dr. Goel explained the conduct of clinical trials, ethical considerations, patient safety, data management, and the role of clinical research organizations in bringing new therapies to the market. Real-world examples and industry experiences made the session highly engaging and informative. The lecture concluded with an interactive question-and-answer session, where students actively participated and sought guidance on career planning, higher education, and industry expectations. The event successfully enhanced students’ understanding of pharmaceutical industry roles and motivated them to explore opportunities in R&D, Regulatory Affairs, and Clinical Research. The Department of Pharmacy expressed its sincere gratitude to Dr. Harmeet Goel for delivering an insightful and inspiring session.
