(2) Fall (2019 – 2020) to Winter (2021 – 2022)

Credit requirements: 18 credits.

(i) Course 1 - Research Methodology (RME-701): 4 credits.

(ii) Course 2: Three activities

- Submitting research proposal for obtaining financial assistance from national funding agencies – 1 credit
- Writing a review paper – 1 credit
- Attending an international seminar/ conference – 2 credits

(iii) Course 3: Statistical Methods (RME-703) – 2 credits

(iv) Course 4: NPTEL/ domain specific courses recommended by SRC – 6 credits

(v) Course 5: Research and Publication Ethics (RPE-701) – 2 credits

(4) Fall (2023 – 2024) till date


Credit requirements: 12 credits
