

Memorandum of Understanding between

Tashkent Medical Academy

and

Galgotias University (India) -

Tashkent Medical Academy, represented by Prof. Boymuradov Shukrat Abdujalilovich, rector, and Galgotias University, India (GU), represented by Prof. Dr Avadhesh Kumar, hereafter "Parties", assuming that the creative cooperation of higher institutions of the two countries will promote further cooperation and mutual understanding between Uzbekistan and _____ and increasing intellectual and innovation resources of two higher institutions have agreed to make and sign the following Memorandum of Understanding on cooperation:

Article 1

Within the framework of existing opportunities, the contracting parties will develop educational, scientific and medical cooperation in various spheres of their life and activity on the basis of equality and mutual benefit.

Article 2

The contracting parties will promote an exchange of professors for educational and scientific research programs.

Article 3

The contracting parties will organize development of the joint international Projects and conducting researches on mutually agreed topics.

Article 4

On the mutually beneficial agreement, the contracting parties will organize an exchange of students, undergraduate students, post-graduate students, persons working for doctor degree programs and scientists with providing conditions necessary for their work.

Article 5

The contracting parties will promote organizing of conferences, seminars, symposiums round tables and master-classes with discussions and publication of the reports thesis and scientific articles of professor and teaching staff of the universities.

Article 6

By commission of one part, the contracting parties will establish scientific contacts and conditions with other educational institutions and research institutes of Uzbekistan and _____.

Article 7

The contracting parties will promote developing cooperation in the field of medical Services by the way of a regular exchange of official delegations and specialists in various fields of medical system. The parties will create a working group for activity coordination within Memorandum.

Article 8

This Memorandum of understanding will remain in force for three years with effect from date of execution of the present MoU and automatically will extend for one more year if only one of the parties will decide to break the MoU. Each of the contracting Parties has the right to break the present Memorandum of understanding, notifying the other part in written form no later than one month in advance. Both the parties can decide mutually at appropriate times regarding the application of article 1 to 7 and the cost incurred thereto, in best interest of both the parties.

Article 9

The present Memorandum of Understanding is made up in two copies in English and Russian languages and has equal legal force.

Article 10

This Memorandum of Understanding does not cover the financial or commercial implications on both the contracting parties.
