

## Sub: Absolute Prohibition on Collection of Cash from Students

## Dear Students,

It has come to the notice of the University Authorities that certain students and faculty members are illegally and informally collecting money from students for various purposes. This is a serious violation of university regulations.

Recently, it has been observed that some students have been illegally organizing a freshers' party outside the University premises and misusing the University's logo without permission. Students are being asked to purchase passes at ₹1200/-. This activity is unauthorized, fraudulent, and strictly prohibited.

All students are hereby strictly warned:

- No cash collection of any kind is permitted by any student, faculty member, or staff member under any circumstances.
- Contributions, if required, will only be made through official University notifications and authorized channels.

The University will not take responsibility for any unauthorized collections. Severe disciplinary action, including suspension/expulsion, will be taken against any individual found involved in organizing, collecting, or promoting such activities.

All students are directed to remain vigilant and report any such incident immediately to the Office of the Dean of Student Welfare/Registrar without delay.

This notification is issued to maintain discipline, transparency, and to safeguard the interests of the student community.
