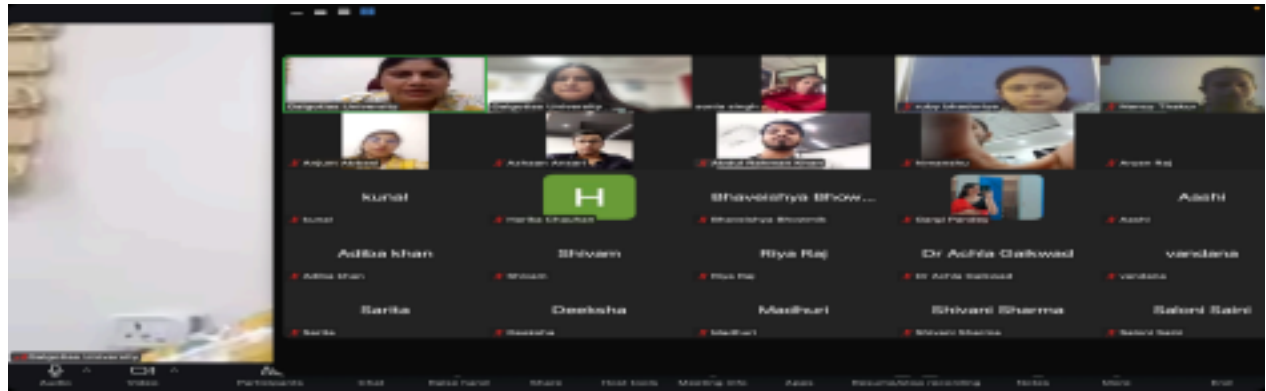

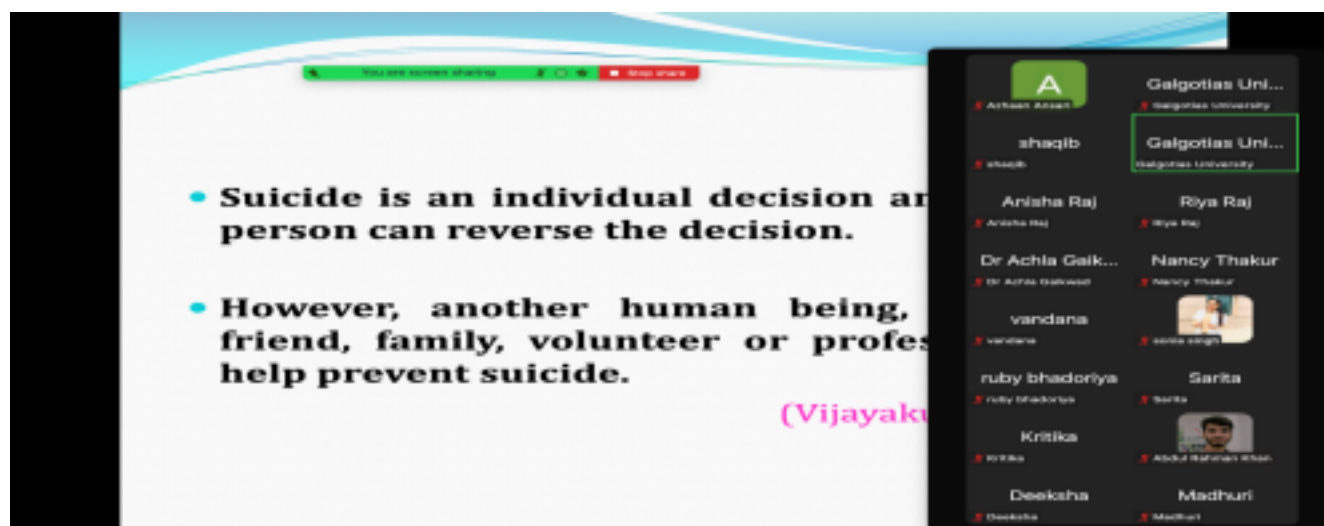

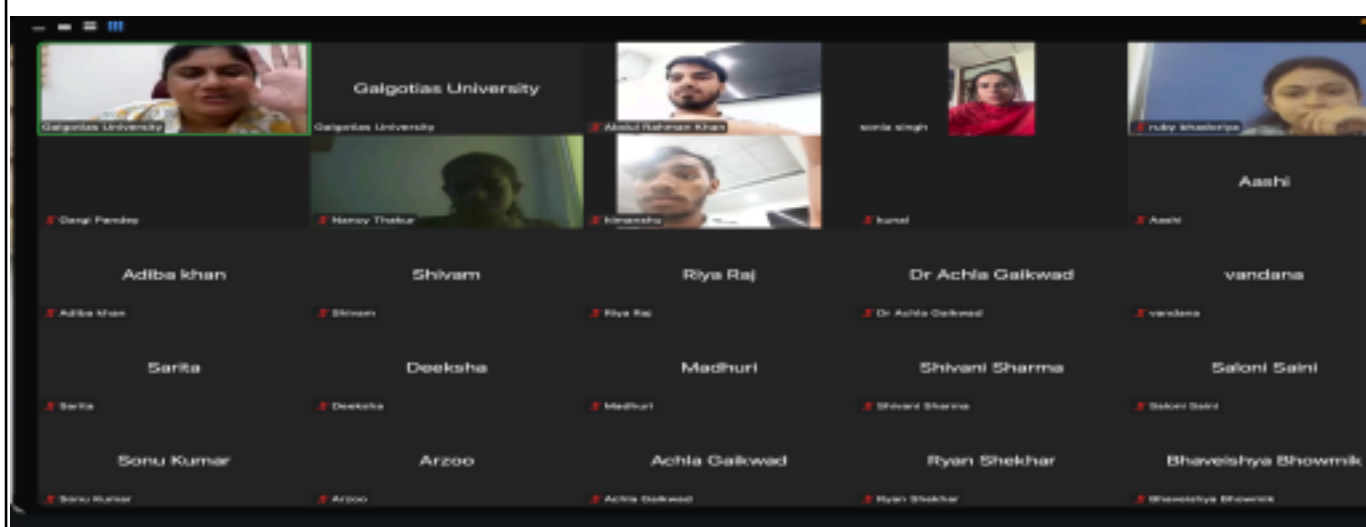

Event Description: On the occasion of *World Suicide Prevention Day 2025*, the Galgotias School of Nursing, Galgotias University, organized a webinar on the theme “**Changing the Narrative on Suicide: Equipping Nursing Students with Compassion & Conversation**” on 11th September 2025 through the Zoom platform. The program aimed to sensitize and empower nursing students with the knowledge, empathy, and skills required to prevent suicide and provide compassionate care to individuals at risk.

The session began with a warm welcome address by **Dr. Sonia Singh, Professor, Galgotias School of Nursing (GSON)**, who highlighted the importance of observing World Suicide Prevention Day and emphasized the vital role of nurses in extending timely support, compassion, and intervention in mental health crises. This was followed by the keynote session delivered by **Dr.**

Achla Dagdu Gaikwad, Assistant Professor, Department of Psychiatric Nursing, Institute of Human Behaviour and Allied Sciences (IHBAS), Delhi. Dr. Gaikwad discussed the urgent need to change the societal and professional narrative around suicide and stressed on equipping nursing students with therapeutic communication skills, empathy, and proactive approaches to identify early warning signs and intervene effectively. She also enriched the discussion with practical examples and interactive reflections, making the session both insightful and engaging.

The session also included an active interaction between the faculty, students, and the speaker, where important questions regarding suicide prevention strategies, risk assessment, and supportive communication were discussed. This dialogue provided students with a deeper understanding of their role in suicide

	prevention and the need to create safe and supportive environments. The webinar concluded with a heartfelt Vote of Thanks delivered by Ms. Deeksha Pandey, who expressed gratitude to the speaker, the faculty, and the students for their enthusiastic participation. Overall, the webinar was highly impactful and aligned with the mission of World Suicide Prevention Day by inspiring nursing students to approach suicide prevention with compassion, empathy, and meaningful conversation. It served as an important step in reinforcing the responsibility of future nurses in promoting mental health and well-being in society.
